**ANNUAL REPORT: 2023-24**  
(1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024)

**Origin and Development:**

The Ramakrishna Mission authorities at Belur Math were persuaded by the Government of India to open a School in Along, West Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh in 1965. Smt. Indira Gandhi, the then Union Minister for information and Broadcasting wrote a letter to Srimat Swami Ranganathanandaji Maharaj, the then Trustee of Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission. The letter is reproduced below:

*Dear Swami Ranganathanandaji,*

*Since my first visit to NEFA and Nagaland, I have felt the need for some missionary work to be done there by non-interested persons. In this context the Ramakrishna Mission naturally came to my mind and I had spoken with Swami Abhayanandaji. However, I was told that the Mission was unable to expand their activities, as they did not have new men coming in.*

*A few days ago, I received a letter from the Governor of Assam, Shri Vishnu Saha, reminding me of my earlier suggestion and information me that now that the Ramakrishna Mission in Burma is likely to be closed, several experienced workers may become available. He wondered if it would be possible for them to go NEFA to start a small mission there doing either educational or medical work or whatever they consider suitable.*

*I am also writing to Swami Abhayananda. But as he has not been keeping very well, I thought I should write to you also and help us in this matter.*

### **About Ramakrishna Mission Aalo:**

The Ramakrishna Mission authorities at Belur Math were persuaded by the Government of India to open a school in Aalo, West Siang Dist., Arunachal Pradesh in 1965. The school was started in thatched huts with 35 students, on 27th July 1966. The foundation stone of the buildings to house the education complex had been laid by Mrs. Indira Gandhi, Prime Minister of India on 25th December 1967. It has now grown to have 1400+ students on its rolls, right from Kindergarten to Std. 12. The school as of today is one of the largest in the state. Ours is the lone school in the district that provides quality education up to Higher Secondary level other than the government sector schools. The school's roll stands around 1400, both boys and girls, while the hostel strength stands at 250 (both senior and junior hostels) only, tribal boys are provided with all kinds of educational and co-curricular facilities within the school premises. Right from the beginning the school has been an English-medium co-educational school, having a mixture of residential and non-residential students, affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The school conducts Lower Primary to Class XII in three streams – Science, Commerce and Humanities. The hostel provides lodging and boarding facility where students of Kindergarten to IX std. are also provided value education, computer training and recreation facilities such as music, dance, drawings, paintings, craft, robotic training etc. and sports like football, basketball, table tennis, badminton, volleyball, athletics, band and drill, multi-gym, etc. 50 Digital Smart classes, 4 STEM Labs and 4 Computer Labs are run for children from Kindergarten to XII std. free of cost. Ultra-modern Laboratory in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Humanities, Geography, etc. are there for the benefit of children free of cost.

Exhaustive libraries with books and DVDs aggregating over 50000 and 25 periodicals are available for school and hostel students. Regular coaching in Band & Drill, Yoga, Sports like football, basketball, Volleyball, Table Tennis, Badminton, etc. is provided to the interested students. NCC and NSS units are run for school and hostel students.

We have a Charitable Indoor Hospital and Mobile Dispensary units for serving poor and needy sections of society. Our hospital has Xray, Pathology, Eye, Dental, ENT units. Besides Indoor and Outdoor units we conduct regular medical camps for eye check-up, dental check-up, skin diseases, paediatrics, gynaecology, etc. Operations are being performed in nearest Government hospitals because of non-availability of honorary surgeons in this remote part of Arunachal. Every year our Indoor and Out-door units serve more than 15000 patients. Our mobile medical unit regularly conduct medical check-ups in the interior part of Arunachal at free of cost. Every year our mobile unit serves around 10000 patients. Health awareness programmes are carried out regularly throughout the year with the help of Audio-Visual unit on eye care, dental care, child care, care of pregnant women and inculcating and encouraging anti-tobacco, non-smoking, anti-alcohol drive. Annually we have 45000 beneficiaries under this programme. We run free 17 non-formal schools for children of kindergarten to std. VI in the remote parts of Arunachal Pradesh. Annually we serve 750 children under this programme. Poultry, Agriculture, Fishery and Bakery units are run for providing nutrition to children. Free mid-day meals are provided to all the day scholars of our school. For students from Kindergarten to std. V are served biscuits, buns, bread, cakes, etc. and rice, lentils, vegetables etc. are served to students from VI to XII std. Carpentry, Tailoring, Printing Press, Electrical, Vehicle, Fabrication & General Maintenance units for giving in-house services to the inmates. Regular fire, winter and distress reliefs are carried out throughout the year in the interior parts of Arunachal by distributing utensils, books, stationery, food grains, blankets, readymade garments to poor and needy. Around 7000 poor and needy persons are served annually under this programme. Despite inclement weather for about eight months, poor road connectivity, difficulty in getting daily provisions, and in hiring trained teachers even at a high salary, with collection of bare minimum fees from the students, meagre and irregular grants from the State/Central governments, the Mission is still flourishing as a centre of academic excellence for tribals in this remote part of our country.

As mentioned above, when the activities, attitudes and approach of the monks won the hearts of the tribals, and the students' strength started increasing, the school started its own Bus-service to bring the non-residential day-scholars from villages and drop them back after school. Today, the school has a fleet of 24 buses, 2 ambulances and 11 light vehicles, which go to the interior villages of West Siang district.

Slowly, side-by-side with the main educational activity, Ramakrishna Mission Aalo (Along) started certain welfare activities for empowering the tribal villagers of West Siang district. These activities include an Audio-visual and mobile medicine unit, which goes to the remote villagers every day with a doctor, a pharmacist, an LCD Audio-visual unit operator, an attendant and medicines. The services and medicines are given free of cost.

By staying true to this principle of 'Value-based education for the tribal child', the institution has ensured a steady input of values and culture at the grass-root level of the state of Arunachal Pradesh. The direct result of this principle can be seen in the brilliant achievements of its students in the last five decades.

### **Computer Training**

With the help of four Computer Labs, basic Computer training was imparted to students from VI to X Std. under CBSE Work Experience programme.

### **Recreation for students**

Our hostellers and day-scholars were provided seasonal facilities for playing Football, Cricket, Volleyball, Badminton, Table-tennis, Chess, Carom, Ludo, etc., and also a multi-gym. They were given balanced entertainment in the form of moral values, educative films & documentary shows on weekends.

### **Provisions for Students**

All hostellers were provided with two sets of PT uniform for their morning drill, one set of Prayer Hall uniform, and a set of School uniform. Textbooks, workbooks, Library reference books & student's notebooks were given to all students. Various stationery items and confectionaries were made available for students at subsidized rates in the Students' store.

### **Students' Store**

The Students' Stores sold books, stationery items, food stuffs, Ramakrishna-Vivekananda literature, photos, lockets, etc., to students in and around Aalo (Along) area.



### **School Bus**

The school operated 24 school buses to transport the day-scholars on daily basis. These buses covered Aalo Town, Darka, Kabu, Pobdi, Bene, Pakam, Gaur Hill & Logum Jining. The Ashrama also owns 2 trucks, 13 light vehicles and 2 two-wheelers.

### **Midday Meal Scheme**

The day scholars are served mid-day meals free of cost. The meals include cakes, biscuits, buns, cakes, pizzas, burgers, rice, dal and seasonal vegetables. The in-house Bakery, agricultural garden & multi-cooking systems supplies the menu items.

### **Spiritual and Cultural Services**

Daily evening prayer was conducted in the Ashrama Shrine. On every Ekadashi day Ramanama Sankirtana was sung. The birthdays of great saints and prophets, popular Hindu festivals and Christmas Eve were celebrated. Sri Sri Saraswati and Vishwakarma Puja attracted a large number of devotees. The general features of the celebrations of the birthdays of Sri Ramakrishna, Holy Mother Sri Sarada Devi and Swami Vivekananda were: Special worship, Homa, Chanting from scriptural texts, Bhajan, Sankirtanam, Distribution of Prasad to devotees.

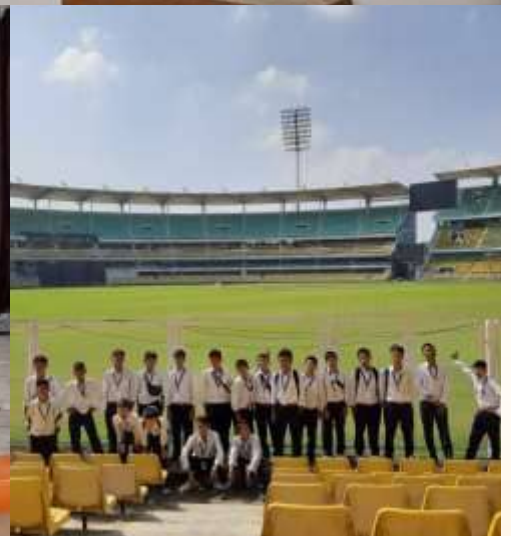

# **EXTRACTS FROM THE MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OF THE RAMAKRISHNA MISSION**

**REGISTERED ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> MAY, 1909, UNDER ACT XXI OF 1860,  
REGISTRATION NO. SO916370 (Legacy Reg. No: 1971/3) OF 1909-10.  
REVISED ACCORDING TO WEST BENGAL ACT XXVI OF 1961.**

1. (a) The name of the Association is THE RAMAKRISHNA MISSION. It may also be spelt as RAMAKRISHNA MISSION.
2. The object of the Association are:
  - a. To impart and promote the study of the Vedanta and its principles as propounded by Sri Ramakrishna and practically illustrated by his own life and of Comparative theology in its widest form.
  - b. (i) To impact, promote and undertake the study of and research in the arts/humanities, sciences, technologies and industries in all their branches both basic and applied.  
(ii) To undertake scientific research in the area of medical sciences.
  - c. To train teachers in all branches of knowledge above-mentioned and enable them to reach the masses.
  - d. To carry on educational work among the masses.
  - e. To establish, maintain, carry on and assist schools, colleges, universities, research institutions, libraries, auditoriums, orphanages, workshops, laboratories, hospitals dispensaries, houses for the aged, the infirm, the invalid and the afflicted, relief and rehabilitation works, and any other educational, medical cultural and social welfare service activities and training institutions and charitable works and institutions of a like nature.
