ANNUAL REPORT: 2022-23
(1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023)

Origin and Development:

The Ramakrishna Mission authorities at Belur Math were persuaded by the Government of India to open a School in Along, West Siang District, Arunachal Pradesh in 1965. Smt. Indira Gandhi, the then Union Minister for information and Broadcasting wrote a letter to Srimat Swami Ranganathanandaji Maharaj, the then Trustee of Ramakrishna Math and Ramakrishna Mission. The letter is reproduced below:

Dear Swami Ranganathanandaji,

Since my first visit to NEFA and Nagaland, I have felt the need for some missionary work to be done there by non-interested persons. In this context the Ramakrishna Mission naturally came to my mind and I had spoken with Swami Abhayanandaji. However, I was told that the Mission was unable to expand their activities, as they did not have new men coming in.

A few days ago, I received a letter from the Governor of Assam, Shri Vishnu Saha, reminding me of my earlier suggestion and information me that now that the Ramakrishna Mission in Burma is likely to be closed, several experienced workers may become available. He wondered if it would be possible for them to go NEFA to start a small mission there doing either educational or medical work or whatever they consider suitable.

I am also writing to Swami Abhayananda. But as he has not been keeping very well, I thought I should write to you also and help us in this matter.

Accordingly, Ramakrishna Mission started a School at Aalo (Along), for the tribals of Arunachal Pradesh in 1966. It was started in a thatched building with 35 students. Eye witnesses of those pioneering days tell of the superhuman love and understanding shown by the monks and the terrible odds faced by them in running the school and making it stand on a firm footing. Gradually, with the passage of time, the school added extensions such as the dairy and the poultry to provide milk and meat nutrition to the residential tribal children, an agriculture field in the campus wasteland, utilizing the refuse of the dairy and poultry to provide vegetables to the residential tribal children, a printing press to provide writing material for the school children, a whole section of vocational training such as tailoring, carpentry, industrial workshop, and computer. This kind of proactive approach of the monks naturally attracted the local tribal families to send their children to the school and the students number started increasing year by year. Today, the school's roll-strength stands at a handsome 1372, both boys and girls, while the hostel strength stands at 227 tribal boys.

Educational Services

Right from the School beginning, the Ramakrishna Mission School at Aalo (Along) has been an English - Medium co-educational school, having a mixture of residential and non-residential students, affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The School conducts lower primary to Class XII in three streams - Science, Commerce and Humanities.

As mentioned above, when the activities, attitudes and approach of the monks won the hearts of the tribals, and the students' strength started increasing, the school started its own Bus-service to bring the non-residential day-scholars from villages and drop them back after school. Today, the school has a fleet of 23 buses, an ambulance and 13 light vehicles, which go the interior villages of West Siang district.

Slowly, side-by-side with the main educational activity, Ramakrishna Mission Aalo (Along) started certain welfare activities for empowering the tribal villagers of West Siang district. These activities include an Audio-visual and mobile medicine unit, which goes to the remote villagers every day with a doctor, a pharmacist, an LCD Audio-visual unit operator, an attendant and medicines. The services and medicines are given free of cost.

By staying true to this principal of 'Value-based education for the tribal child', the institution has ensured a steady input of values and culture at the grass-root level of the state of Arunachal Pradesh. The direct result of this principle can be seen in the brilliant achievements of its students in the last five decades.

Various aspects of personality such as good habits, truthfulness, integrity etc. were taught and discussed with the students by teachers and various guests. The camp ended with an educational tour of the Jammu and Kashmir Light Infantry Battalion Army Camp. The camp was attended by 100 students of classes 5 and 6.
- ◆ Miss Sanghamitra Jana secured 95.8% marks in AISSCE 2020-21 and stood first in our School.

Water Tank

A Water Tank constructed for supplying 6 lac liters of water on daily basis to school and hostel children.

Construction of Central (School) Office commenced.

Auditorium cum Indoor stadium constructed for badminton, basket ball, table tennis, carom and multi-gym facility.

Shramik Bhavan

2 Shramik Bhavans constructed for 30 casual workers (helpers, cleaners, sweepers, watchman, etc.) with toilet facility.

Higher Secondary School Gate

A gate is constructed for Higher Secondary School.

Garage

2 garages constructed for keeping additional school buses and other vehicles.

Compound Wall

Compound wall construction started to cover 74 acres of Ashrama land.

150 Dining Tables purchased for school & hostel students and Teaching and supporting staff.

School Buses

5 School Buses purchased to bring the non-residential day-scholars from villages to the School and to drop them back after school.

Ambulance

An Ambulance purchased for hospital and mobile medical unit.

2 mobile medical vans purchased to cater the need of local patients from interior parts of Arunachal.

A two wheeler purchased for school girls for emergency health care.

Electrification

Overhead electrification done for 74 acres of Ashrama.

5 pairs of Tabla and Harmoniums purchased for school and hostel students.

50 CCTVs installed for Schools, Hostels, Dining Hall, Kitchen, Garage, etc.

Science Labs

2 Science labs (Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Geography) for Secondary and Higher Secondary Schools were renovated with modern furniture and equipment.

Light and Sound System

A light and sound system installed for 3 Auditoriums.

Steam Cooking and Serving Trolleys

A Steam Cooking System and 31 trolleys purchased for serving food to 1400 students.

Student Store

Students' store was constructed for school and hostel students to serve their daily needs.

Two Wheeler Stand

Two wheeler stand constructed for parking vehicles of teaching and supporting staff.

Furniture for School and Hostel

500 Desk benches of School and Hostels were renovated.

Vivekananda Sankriti Centre

133 Boys and girls from different schools of Aalo were imparted on every Wednesdays & Sunday value education i.e. Recital of Stotras, Bhajans, Dance, Painting, Drawing, Spoken English, Computer Programming, Table Tennis, Badminton, Basket Ball, Foot Ball, Carom, etc.

Computer Training

With the help of two Computer Labs, basic Computer training has been imparted to students from Class VI to Class X under CBSE Work Experience programme.

Recreation for students

Our Hostellers and day-scholars were provided seasonal facilities for playing Football, Cricket, Volleyball, Badminton, Table-tennis, Chess, Carom, Ludo, etc., and also a multi-gym. They were given balanced entertainment in the form of moral values, educative films & documentary shows on weekends.

Provisions for Students

All Hostellers were provided with two sets of PT uniform for their morning drill, one set of Prayer Hall uniform, and a set of School uniform. Textbooks, workbooks, Library reference books & student's notebooks were given to all students. Various stationery items and confectionaries were made available for students at subsidized rates in the Students' store.

Students' Store

The Students' Stores sold books, stationery items, food stuffs, Ramakrishna-Vivekananda literature, photos, lockets, etc., to students in and around Aalo (Along) area.

School Bus

The school operated 23 school buses to transport the day-scholars daily. These buses covered Aalo Town, Darka, Kabu, Pobdi, Wak, Bene, Pakam, Gaur Hill & Logum, Jining. The Ashrama also owns 1 truck, 13 light vehicles and 2 two-wheelers.

Midday Meal Scheme

The day scholars are served mid-day meals free of cost. The meals include cakes, biscuits, buns, rice, dal and seasonal vegetables. The in-house Bakery, agricultural garden & multi-cooking systems supplies the menu items.

Spiritual and Cultural Services

Daily evening prayer was conducted in the Ashrama Shrine. On every Ekadashi day Ramana Sankirtana was sung. The birthdays of great saints and prophets, popular Hindu festivals and Christmas Eve were celebrated. Sri Sri Saraswati and Vishwakarma Worship attracted a large number of devotees. The general features of the celebrations of the birthdays of Sri Ramakrishna, Holy Mother Sri Sarada Devi and Swami Vivekananda were: special worship, Homa, chanting from scriptural texts, bhajan, sankirtan, distribution of Prasad to devotees.

EXTRACTS FROM THE MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OF THE RAMAKRISHNA MISSION

**REGISTERED ON THE 4TH MAY, 1909, UNDER ACT XXI OF 1860,
REGISTRATION NO. SO916370 (Legacy Reg. No: 1971/3) OF 1909-10.
REVISED ACCORDING TO WEST BENGAL ACT XXVI OF 1961.**

1. (a) The name of the Association is THE RAMAKRISHNA MISSION. It may also be spelt as RAMAKRISHNA MISSION.
2. The object of the Association are:
 - a. To impart and promote the study of the Vedanta and its principles as propounded by Sri Ramakrishna and practically illustrated by his own life and of Comparative theology in its widest form.
 - b. (i) To impact, promote and undertake the study of and research in the arts/humanities, sciences, technologies and industries in all their branches both basic and applied.
(ii) To undertake scientific research in the area of medical sciences.
 - c. To train teachers in all branches of knowledge above-mentioned and enable them to reach the masses.
 - d. To carry on educational work among the masses.
 - e. To establish, maintain, carry on and assist schools, colleges, universities, research institutions, libraries, auditoriums, orphanages, workshops, laboratories, hospitals dispensaries, houses for the aged, the infirm, the invalid and the affiliated, relief and rehabilitation works, and any other educational, medical cultural and social welfare service activities and training institutions and charitable works and institutions of a like nature.
 - f. To take up development and general welfare activities for the benefit of the underprivileged / backward / tribal people of the society without any discrimination.
 - g. To print and publish and to sell or distribute, gratuitously or otherwise, journals, periodicals, books or leaflets that the Association may think desirable for the promotion of its objects.
 - h. To carry on any other work which may seem to the Association capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with and calculated directly or indirectly to promote any of the before-mentioned objects.
